

# Stepping Stones Toward Member Engagement and Leadership in UUFA

## Level I

Attend Sunday activities: Forum and Service  
Attend the weekly potluck  
Attend adult R.E. classes (e.g., learning UU history)  
Attend “just for fun” events  
Attend Men’s Breakfast or Women’s lunches  
Participate in Simple Saturdays (young family potluck)

## Level II

Become a member (or a “serious friend”)  
Engage children in R.E.  
Make a pledge  
Make coffee Sunday morning  
Arrange and bring flowers for Sunday morning  
Join SGM  
Assist with event (e.g., bring food for a reception)  
Join other groups such as Goddess Group, Poetry, Writing, Book Group, Second Lookers,  
Help with the yard sale or other fundraising events  
Bring food to contribute to Fourth Sunday Lunch  
Join the choir or drumming group  
Volunteer to usher  
Attend the Mountain Fall retreat or Southern Region UU meeting

## Level III

Teach in Religious Education Program (e. g., OWL - Our Whole Lives)  
Lead a Youth Group  
Facilitate a Small Group Ministry group  
Coordinate a Care Ring  
Organize/coordinate an event or project (e. g., yard sale, auction)  
Join a committee such as Building and Grounds, Communications Committee, Green Sanctuary, Ethical Eating Group, Forum Planning Committee, Social Action Committee, Religious Education, Worship Arts, Interfaith Hospitality Network, Our Daily Bread (serving meals to homeless), Volunteer Recognition Committee, Partner Church (Okland Transylvania),  
Become involved with regional or national UUA events – Attend GA and SUUSI (Southeast Unitarian Universalist Summer Institute)

## Level IV

Chair a working Committee/serve on the Leadership Council  
Serve on Pastoral Care Committee  
Serve as Overall Coordinator of SGM groups  
Serve on or Chair the Committee on Shared Ministry  
Serve on Membership Committee, Finance Committee, Nominating Committee

## Level V

Train to be and serve as a Lay Minister  
Serve on the UUFA Board of Trustees, Executive Committee
